**Why fall is the right time to plant perennials:**

- the cool air is easier on humans and plants, less water is required
- the soil is still warm from Summer compared to the cool soils of Spring
- plants tend to experience less transplant shock
- plants spend their energy establishing good root systems rather than 'feeding' leaves and blooms. This allows the plant to spend next year's energy on flowering and surviving the heat.

Highland Moor's native plant material is propagated and grown in Woodford Co. Many species are rescued from urban development in the Bluegrass. Your purchase helps Highland Moor continue to make available plant material necessary to reforest the Bluegrass.
